

NEW STUDENT & FAMILY PROGRAMS

New Student & Family Programs (NSFP) supports new students and families throughout their transition and involvement at the University of Colorado Boulder.

In order to aid in the transition to CU Boulder, all incoming undergraduate students must complete the Online Experience (<https://www.colorado.edu/orientation/online-experience/>) in order to attend New Student Orientation and register for classes. The Online Experience requires activation of a student's IdentiKey (<https://identikey.colorado.edu/>) and can be accessed in Buff Portal (<https://buffportal.colorado.edu/>). The Online Experience and New Student Orientation are critical to the college experience as they help incoming students learn more about student success, advising, registration and campus resources.
